

# STATE CLINICAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

In conjunction with the American Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation (ASHF), the North Carolina Speech, Hearing and Language Association annually selects a member to receive an award for recent (within the last three years) contributions to the advancement of clinical practice in speech/language pathology and audiology. The member chosen will receive a plaque from NCSHLA and a certificate from the ASHF. The North Carolina Clinical Achievement Award winner then becomes the state's nominee for the Louis DiCarlo award presented by ASHF at the ASHA convention.

Nominees must be NCSHLA Active or Life members in good standing. They are not limited by type of clinical achievement or activity. Typical examples of qualifying activities include:

- achievement with a single client or group of clients
- clinical services programming
- program development
- achievement in a government agency or a state or local organization
- clinical teaching, research, or administration.
