2. Minimum grade point of average of 3.0 in major.
3. Current paid Student membership in the North Carolina Speech, Hearing and Language Association.
4. Completed APPLICATION FORM, accompanied by TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION from college/university faculty members, and a LIST OF CREDITS (official transcript not required).

Application form, undergraduate and graduate credits where applicable, and letters of recommendation must be sent to the Membership & Recognition Committee no later than January 15, 2010, in order to be considered for award at the 2010 NCSHLA convention in Raleigh.
